## About The College

The foundation of the college was hosted by Prof. Late Birendra Mohan Acharya of Kalyani B.T. College and Lt. Col. Dwijendinath Bhattacharyya, supreme authority of Bhagirathi Silpashram, where two storied buildings was annexed to the Shilpashram to form Bhagirathi Post Graduate Teachers' Training College affiliated under Calcutta University on and from 1st July 1971. After a short while it became affiliated to the University of Kalyani with changed named as Bhagirathi College of Education. Later with blessings from Srimat Swami Sachinandan Das Mohanta Maharajji who donated 36.5 decimal land to the college. The institution was named after him as Shimurali Sachinandan College of Education(SSCE) on 1984 affiliated under University of Kalyani till 2015. The College is only West Bengal Govt. -aided Teachers' training college in Nadia District, affiliated to Baba Saheb Ambedkar Education university (Erstwhile The West Bengal University of Teachers' Training, Education Planning and Administration since 2015) and recognised by NCTE, accredited by NAAC with Grade 'A' in 2016. The college is run by able Governing Body with teaching and non-teaching staff. There are number of committees and sub-committees headed by the teachers along with student council members. The college shares a cordial relationship with local schools where the students annually visit to complete their internship.
