#### 1.b.1. World Environment Day:

World Environment Day was observed on 5th June, 2025 by the students of our college under the guidance of Sharmistha Pramanik, Convener, Green Audit Subcommittee, SSCE. Different activities are performed in our college premises as well as the practice teaching schools.

**1.b.2. We and Environment, Medicinal Garden, Plantation of seedling:**

An Edited book Volume entitled "We & Environment" edited by Dr. Trishna Gowsami (Kundu), Teacher-in-Charge and Sharmistha Pramanik, Asst. Prof. (Zoology), was published on the occasion of World Environment Day, 5th June, 2025 under the Research and Publication Subcommittee. The day was celebrated by harvesting Medicinal plants, planting of seedlings, offering of mango trees "Ayush" and "Atwaja" to the practice-teaching schools, i.e., Shimurali Upendra Vidyabhaban (H.S.) & Shimurali Upendra Vidya Bhaban for Girls (H.S.) and spreading of seed bombs to the community.



**1.c.1. Education Fair:**

Under the robust leadership of Dr. Trishna Goswami (Kundu) (Teacher-in-Charge) and the profound guidance of Shri Tibrajyoti Das (President, Governing Body), SSCE has organized for the first time, Education Fair-2025 following the directives of the Government of West Bengal. This event took place on April 22, 23 and 24, 2025 at the college campus. The Education Fair was commenced with the inaugural chanting performed by the students of our college. Felicitation of honorable dignitaries was done followed by inaugural lamp lighting by Mr. Shubhankar Singha, President, Governing Body, Chakdaha College.

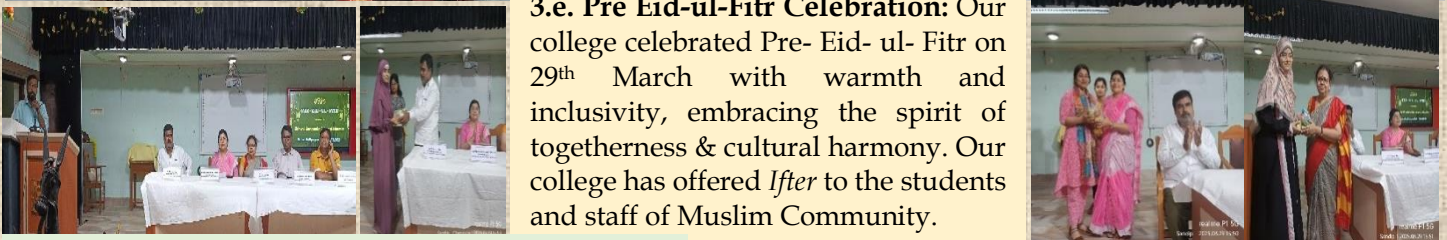
